Academic Focus

We champion reading as the foundation for all learning and scholastic progress and work to develop strong reading skills in all students. Our school embraces the lowa Core curriculum model. Using that, our teachersreview how students are meeting standards in literacy, mathematics, science, social studies and 21st century learning, and work to enhance the progress of each student. Our teachers engage students using instruction with various types of technology including iPads, interactive whiteboards, and Chromebooks.

Academic Competitions

Our middle school students participate in Quiz Bowl, annual math competitions and our 7-8 graders participate in Iowa online competitions.

LIFE (Living Instruments of Faith Everyday) Team

Our LIFE Team is a group of students in grades 6, 7 and 8 who put their faith into action by working togetheron community service projects in and outside of the Sioux City area. Our school has also developed an amazing relationship with the Sisters of St. Francis in Dubuque, lowa, supporting their community with service projects and more.

Middle School Fine Arts

For students needing extra attention, we offer tutoring, student mentoring, area education agency services and other individualized programs.

Vocal: Music classes are offered twice a week. All middle school student are involved in vocal music and perform at Christmas and spring concerts. Many also perform with the show choir Genesis along with other BHCS middle school students. Genesis showcases its talent and competes with other middle school choirs at the Heelan "Crusader Classic" in February, an annual mega-event for area show choirs.

Vocal music students are also audition for and perform in the all school spring musical. The past two years have featured student talent in "Little Mermaid" and "Aladdin Jr."

Band: Students in grades 5-8 are invited to join the band under the directions of our talented instructors. Band students perform at Christmas concerts, spring concerts and more. Private lessons are also available.

Strings: Students are invited to join the elective Strings program, which is offered in after school lessons. Students showcase their skills in violin, viola, and cello concerts twice a year.

Student Leadership

Students at Mater Dei are encouraged to show leadership in many different ways. LIFE Team and Franciscan Common Venture are two service-minded leadership opportunities where students can help plan retreats, assemblies and service projects.
