Academic Focus

We champion reading as the foundation for all learning and scholastic progress and work to develop strong reading skills in all students. With our faith-infused curriculum we review and advance the progress of each student in the areas of literacy, mathematics, science, social studies and 21st century learning. Our teachers engage students using instruction with iPads, interactive whiteboards and chromebooks.

Higher Test Scores

Our student test scores are higher than local, state and national averages.

Individualized Instruction

Our small class size and support staff allow for teachers to meet the needs of all students in their classroom. We offer Title I reading services as well as ESL (English as a second language) services. Students that excel are pushed to continue to achieve at high levels through differentiated instruction.

Faith Formation and Service

Students attend Mass each week and have opportunities to be actively involved in planning and being part of the liturgy.

Guidance and Counseling

A full-time school counselor regularly visits classrooms to promote positive attitudes, choices, and interpersonal relationships among students. In individual and group interactions, our counselors focus on the personal and academic needs of students. By helping students deal with classroom and personal challenges, they help students succeed in school.

Positive Behavior Program and Student Leadership

At Sacred Heart, our Positive Behavior Supports Program rewards students for positive behaviors. The program gives older students leadership opportunities with school assemblies and other activities.

Middle School Fine Arts

Vocal: Music classes are offered twice a week. All middle school students are involved in vocal music and perform at Christmas and spring concerts. Show choir: Genesis

Bishop Heelan System Sports Program

6th grade: volleyball and wrestling (practice only)

7th grade: football, wrestling, cross country, volleyball, basketball, track, soccer, golf

8th grade: football, wrestling, cross country, volleyball, basketball, track, soccer, golf; 8th grade boys can try out for freshman baseball and 8th grade girls for softball.

We Are Heelan Sports Program

This program, named in part for the Crusaders, is a private program that supplements the athletic opportunities in the Bishop Heelan system.

FAQs

Is transportation available?

Yes. For those living within certain boundaries of Sioux City, bussing to and from school is provided by the public school. Those living in South Dakota can participate in private van transportation through Travel Plus, home from school.
