Highlights of 2014-2015 (and thru Nov. 1, 2015)

Academic Progress

- New 1-8 math textbooks were purchased.
- STAR Reading Assessments were started to monitor student achievement.
- Five Heelan students earned National Merit recognition.
- 98% of students went on to college, 83% to four-year colleges.
- 49% of seniors earned of 12 or more college credits.
- Heelan's Quiz Bowl Team qualified for the National Tournament.

Quality Staff and Programs

- Teachers received ongoing professional education.Heelan science teachers helped teach a summer science camp and another conducted summer research at ISU.
- Barb Swanson, kindergarten teacher at Holy Cross School, was a Teacher of Excellence at the 2014 Bishop's Dinner.
- Mary Fischer, Mater Dei School Principal, received the Good Shepherd 's Award at the 2015 Bishop's Dinner.
- Sacred Heart School received STEM grants for robotics, fuel cell cars, coding, windmill studies and other classroom projects.
- Mater Dei won a Healthiest Iowa Award from the State of Iowa and become a certified Blue Zone school.
- Sacred Heart School began offering Beyond the Bell after school.

Community Service by Students and Volunteers

- LIFE Team Middle School students took Urban Plunge trips to help those in poverty in Minneapolis and Des Moines.
- Bishop Heelan students served others in Mission Mississippi.
- All students served the community in the annual special Homecoming Week Service Day.
- Middle school and high schools students provided Thanksgiving Dinners to needy families.
- Heelan "Miracle Makers" helped a seriously ill child.
- A new TeamMates program matched volunteer mentors with elementary students to enhance success.
- Numerous school projects helped others.

- Prayer begins and closes each school day.
- Students attended Mass together every week.
- Weekday Masses continued in the Heelan High Chapel.
- Elementary school projects reinforced prayer and faith.
- Fr. Shane Deman joined Heelan High as school Chaplain.

Athletic Achievements

- Memorial Field received a new synthetic surface track.
- Girls Basketball went to state in 2015.
- Girls Volleyball went to state in 2014 and 2015.
- Girls Soccer became State 3A Champions!
- Boys Soccer went to state.
- Boys and Girls Track athletes went to state.
- Boys and Girls Cross Country runners competed at state.
- Football 2014 were state champion runner-ups and the 2015 team completed an 8-2 season.

Advancement Success for the Bishop Heelan School System

- The Pride Campaign funded the opening of the new \$15 million Fine Arts Building in Fall 2014.
- The Annual Fund and Heelan Auction brought in \$437,000 to support our schools.
- The Gold Club raised \$142,000 in 2014 and continues to raise funds in 2015 for a goal of \$200,000.
- The Monsignor Lafferty Tuition Foundation brought in \$710,000 in 2014 to support grants for 600 students.
- Missouri River Development (MRHD) awarded Bishop Heelan \$100,000 for the new Memorial Field Track.
 - The Gilchrist Foundation awarded Heelan nearly \$18,000 for accoustical music shells for the Fine Arts Auditorium.
 - Intel awarded a \$10,000 grant to Holy Cross School.
 - Ho-Chunk donated a bank building to BHCS to serve as a new administration building.



Student Performance

lowa Assessment Scores for Proficiency 2014-15

All students in grades 2-8 took the full battery of Iowa Assessment tests in language arts, math, science and social studies. The Iowa Assessments are one snapshot of student growth and proficiency that is used to monitor student learning and instruction.

Students are given a *National Standard Score* (NSS) score that describes a student's achievement on a standard scale. BHCS reports lowa Assessment scores for grades 4, 8 and 11 in our yearly Annual Progress Report to the state of lowa.
